The state of the water, is now such, that the boats cannot ascend the river to Laramie — I likewise am satisfied from the best information, that the army can march to the foot of the Rapids, sooner by 4 or 5 days, by Urbanna, than by Laramie, you will therefore make provision for the transportation of the Baggage of the fourth Reg^t, & the detachment under the command of Captain McCook — the most direct route from Dayton to Urbanna — & the stores below will likewise be sent to Urbanna. — I wish you to make this communication to Fort. Edwards, & all the Hospital stores at Dayton, will be forwarded to Urbanna. I have given directions to your Deputy, with respect to every thing here — I hope to have the pleasure of seeing you at Urbanna as soon as possible.
