Sir

The state of the water is now such, that the boats cannot ascend the river to Lorimies -----I likewise am satisfied from the best information that the Army can march to the foot of the Rapids, sooner by 4 or 5 days, by Urbana, than by Lorimies, you will therefore make provision for the transportation of the Baggage of the fourth Regt., and the detachment under the command of Ensign McCabe – the most direct route from Dayton to Urbana-----All the stores below will likewise be sent to Urbana-----I wish you to make this communication to Lieut. Edwards, and all the Hospital stores at Dayton, will be forwarded to Urbana. I have given directions to your Deputy, with respect to erything here-----
I hope to have the pleasure of seeing you at Urbana as soon as possible.
